- • Coaches will not
 1. Use abusive or foul language
 2. Threaten or intentionally inflict physical or emotional injury upon anyone
 3. Touch a child in any way that could be considered sexual
 4. Be in a one on one situation with a child

Procedures

If any incident of sexual, physical, or emotional abuse is reported the coach will immediately be dismissed of coaching responsibilities.

A quick and complete investigation of the report will take place.

If the coach is found guilty the proper authorities will be notified.

The confidentiality of any one who makes such a report will be protected.
